

## Queensland Walks' Walk Week 2020 Competition

### Terms and Conditions

1. Information on how to enter the competition forms part of the competition conditions.
2. Competition entry is deemed acceptance of these competition conditions.
3. Prizes: There are 8 prizes for this randomly selected competition. 7 individual registrant random prizes, and 1 major random prize for a registered team.

#### **Individual registrant random prize:**

Prize category 1. Individual video *and* audio recording of a Walk Week related activity:

- 1 x \$50 voucher of your choice for an individual that posts a video or videos of their daily walk between Monday 17<sup>th</sup> August, 2020 – Sunday 23<sup>rd</sup> August 2020. Prize donated by Queensland Walks.
- 1 x \$50 voucher of your choice for an individual that posts an audio sample or daily samples of their daily walk between Monday 17<sup>th</sup> August, 2020 – Sunday 23<sup>rd</sup> August 2020. Prizes are donated by Queensland Walks.

Prize category 2. Individual photo with Snap Send Solve

- 5 x \$50 vouchers of your choice for an individual that posts photos of their daily walk between Wednesday 19<sup>th</sup> August, 2020 – Sunday 23<sup>rd</sup> August 2020 via the Snap Send Solve app. Prizes are donated by Snap Send Solve.

#### **Major team or group prize:**

Prize category 3.

- 1x \$250 voucher for a work team that shares at least one team photo, video or audio each week day from Monday 17<sup>th</sup> August, 2020 - Friday 21<sup>st</sup> August, 2020. The winning team will nominate their caterer or restaurant of choice and Queensland Walks will make payment for the voucher to that organisation/team on an agreed date.

Prizes are not exchangeable or transferable, unless deemed so by the prize provider, and cannot be redeemed for cash. If the full amount of the voucher is not redeemed, the unused balance will be forfeited. Any additional expenses incurred by the prize winners, other than those outlined in these competition conditions, are the responsibility of the prize winners. Prizes are themselves subject to the specific terms and conditions of the prize providers.

The prizes must be redeemed by the prize winner unless the prize winner is under 18 years of age, in which case the prize winner's parent or guardian is required to redeem the prize on the prize winner's behalf.

4. The competition period: The competition opens at 6.00 am on Monday 17 August 2020 and closes at 11:59pm on Sunday 23 August 2020.

5. How to enter:

Individuals must register for [Walk Week via the Queensland Walks website](#).

If an individual would like to participate as a team (workplace or recreational), then one person must register the team using the same form.

Individuals participating in Walk Week will post photos, videos and or audio files daily of their experience and celebration of walking and participating in Walk Week on each day of Walk Week. We encourage you to share your walking celebration with us and include #walkweek:

Teams who register for Walk Week and post photos, videos or audio of their team walking and participating in Walk Week each business day from Monday 17 – Friday 21 August 2020 via the daily posts on the Qld Walks Facebook page @QueenslandWalksIncorporated (using #walkweek) will automatically be entered in the random draw for the \$250 catered lunch.

6. Eligibility: To be eligible to enter this competition, the registrant must:

#### **Prize category 1. Individual video or audio randomly drawn prize**

- **Video walking story:** Register individually for [Walk Week 2020](#) and post one or more daily video/s via [Queensland Walks Facebook](#) or [upload your video/s](#) sharing your walking story, *or*
- **Audio walking story:** Register individually for [Walk Week 2020](#) and post or submit one or more audio recording/s videos via [Queensland Walks Facebook](#) or [upload your video](#) sharing your walking story.

#### **Prize category 2. Individual photo randomly drawn prize**

To be eligible for the individual prize of a \$50 voucher, registrants need to register individually for Walk Week 2020 and submit a photo via the [Snap Send Solve app](#), using 'Incident type: Queensland Walks - Walk Week Competition' between Wednesday 19 – Sunday 23<sup>rd</sup> August, 2020. The Snap Send Solve app must be used to be eligible for the random prize. [See instructions](#)

#### **Prize category 3. Team or group: randomly drawn prize**

Register individually for [Walk Week 2020](#). The nominated team or group leader should register the team or group name and information and use the team name used during registration. To be eligible for the team or group prize you must:

1. Post at least one team photo, video or audio participating in a 2020 Walk Week related activity to [Queensland Walks Facebook](#) **each day** from Monday 17 to Friday 23 August;
3. Mention your team name so we can identify your entry
4. Be over the age of 18 *or* have the consent of a parent or guardian to enter the competition.

7. Competition Draw: Winners will be randomly drawn by Snap Send Solve sponsored individual prizes, and a Qld Walks Executive Committee member for the other individual and team/group prize. The winner of the individual or team prizes will be the eligible entry randomly drawn first.

8. Winner Notification: The winner will be notified by email/telephone, on or before Tuesday 2 September 2020 by Qld Walks and Snap Send Solve. If the winner is not contactable, Qld Walks and Snap Send Solve will continue to attempt to contact them until Friday 7 September 2020.

9. Re-Draw: If the winner does not claim the prize or cannot be contacted by phone or email by Friday 7 September, the Promoter will redraw the prize winner until a contactable winner has been located and the prize is claimed.

10. No Liability of Promoter: The Promoter accepts no responsibility whatsoever for late, misplaced, lost or ineligible entries. The Promoter makes no representations or warranties as to the quality, suitability or merchantability of the prizes. To the extent permitted by law, the Promoter is not liable for any loss or damage whatsoever which is suffered (including but not limited to direct or consequential loss) or for any personal injury sustained in connection with the entry into the competition or acceptance of the prize. This paragraph is not intended to exclude any liability which cannot be excluded under Australian consumer protection laws. Any such liability is limited to the resupply of the prize.

Force Majeure: If for any reason this competition is not capable of running as planned (including due to infection by computer virus, bugs, tampering, unauthorised intervention, fraud, technical failures or any other causes beyond the control of the Promoter), which corrupts or affect the administration, security, fairness, integrity or proper conduct of this competition, the Promoter reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to take any action that may be available, and to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the competition. The

Promoter reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify all entries from any individual who tampers with, or benefits from tampering with, the entry process which as a result corrupts or affects the administration, security, fairness, integrity or proper conduct of the competition.

13. In the case of the intervention of any outside agent or event which naturally changes the result or prevents or hinders its determination, including but not limited to vandalism, power failures, tempests, natural disasters, acts of God, civil unrest, strikes; the Promoter may in its absolute discretion cancel the competition and recommence it from the start on the same conditions.

14. Queensland Walks reserves the right to modify these terms and conditions at any time and to cancel or amend the competition at any time without notice or further recourse to the entrants.

15. By entering the competition, all team members and people photographed acknowledge that Qld Walks has full permission to use or reproduce data and posted images to be used for the purposes of Qld Walks reporting, funding and communications.
