

Queensland Walks Month 2021

Competition Terms and Conditions

1. The Queensland Walks Month 2021 competition (the competition) is available to registrants of Queensland Walks Month 2021. Registration is free for residents of Queensland, and can be completed at any time before 27 September 2021 via www.queenslandwalks.org.au/WalkMonth2021

Individuals under the age of 18 years must have consent from a parent or guardian to register for Queensland Walks Month 2021 and participate in the competition.

2. The competition opens at 12:00 am on Wednesday 1 September 2021 and closes at 11:59pm on Sunday 3 October 2021. Registration is a requirement to be eligible for the competition.

3. Information on how to enter the competition forms part of the Competition Terms and Conditions.

4. Competition entry is deemed acceptance of these Competition Terms and Conditions.

5. Queensland Walks Month 2021 includes four week-long themes:

- *Week 1: Walking for recreation (1 – 12 September)*
- *Week 2: Walking for health (13 – 19 September)*
- *Week 3: Walking for transport (20 – 26 September)*
- *Week 4: Walkable places and spaces (26 September – 1 October)*

6. Individual registrants may enter the competition via the Queensland Walks Month 2021 webpage <https://queenslandwalks.org.au/walkmonth2021/> by submitting a;

- **Photo**
- **Story**
- And / Or **Video** (between 5 and 20 seconds)

7. All submissions are to be captured or created by the registrant or a team member of the registrant during a walk, roll, run or stroll within the specified week of Queensland Walks Month 2021.

8. Every submission counts. Registrants may enter a photo, story and video but do not have to enter all three to be eligible. Registrants may prefer to enter only a story/s, a video/s, a photo/s or a number of each per week.

9. For a greater chance to win, registrants may enter as many times as they wish per week. The photo, video, or story must be an original piece, and you must be the copyright owner and have permission of those featured to submit the walking photo, video or story.

10. Once a photo, video or story has been submitted to Queensland Walks, Queensland Walks will approve the submission which will be posted on the Queensland Walks Month website <https://queenslandwalks.org.au/walkmonth2021/> and all registrants will be encouraged to vote for their favourite submission. In order to vote, individuals must be registered for Queensland Walks Month 2021.

11. The 10 submissions with the most votes from each week will go into a random draw to win.

I'm an Individual Registrant – what can I win and how?

In Week 1: Walk for recreation (1 – 12 September)

- Submit a photo/s to be voted into the draw to win a prize pack or voucher valued between \$50 and \$150.
- Submit a story/s to be voted into the draw to win a prize pack or voucher valued between \$50 and \$150
- Submit a video/s to be voted into the draw to win a prize pack or voucher valued between \$50 and \$150

In Week 2. Walk for health (13 – 19 September)

- Submit a photo/s to be voted into the draw to win a prize pack or voucher valued between \$50 and \$150.
- Submit a story/s to be voted into the draw to win a prize pack or voucher valued between \$50 and \$150
- Submit a video/s to be voted into the draw to win a prize pack or voucher valued between \$50 and \$150

In Week 3. Walk for transport (20 – 26 September)

- Submit a photo/s to be voted into the draw to win a prize pack or voucher valued between \$50 and \$150.
- Submit a story/s to be voted into the draw to win a prize pack or voucher valued between \$50 and \$150
- Submit a video/s to be voted into the draw to win a prize pack or voucher valued between \$50 and \$150

In Week 4. Walkable places and spaces (26 September – 3 October)

- Submit a photo/s to be voted into the draw to win a prize pack or voucher valued between \$50 and \$150.

- Submit a video/s to be voted into the draw to win a prize pack or voucher valued between \$50 and \$150

We're a team. What can we win and how?

Snap Send Solve App instructions:

1. Download the Snap Send Solve app: free from the App Store and Google Play
2. Confirm your location
3. Select the Category 'Community'
4. Select the Incident Type 'Queensland Walks - Walk Month'
5. Snap a great photo while on your walk (the more creative the better!)

6. Fill out notes and any additional fields
7. Send report
8. Snap Send Solve will choose one lucky group or team to win!

Submit at least 1 photo per week relevant to the following themes

- *Week 1: Walk for recreation (1 – 12 September)*
- *Week 2: Walk for health (13 – 19 September)*
- *Week 3: Walk for transport (20 – 26 September)*
- *Week 4: Walkable places and spaces (26 September – 1 October)*

Subject to approval by Queensland Walks, submissions will be posted on the Queensland Walks Month webpage <https://queenslandwalks.org.au/walkmonth2021/> and all registrants will be encouraged to vote for their favourite group or team photo submission. In order to vote, individuals must be registered for Queensland Walks Month 2021.

12. The random draw for all prizes will be conducted by Snap Send Solve and Queensland Walks.

13. Prizes are not exchangeable or transferable, unless deemed so by the prize provider, and cannot be redeemed for cash. If the full amount of the voucher is not redeemed, the unused balance will be forfeited. The Promoter reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify all entries from any individual who tampers with, or benefits from tampering with, the entry process which as a result corrupts or affects the administration, security, fairness, integrity or proper conduct of the competition.

In the case of the intervention of any outside agent or event which naturally changes the result or prevents or hinders its determination, including but not limited to vandalism, power failures, tempests, natural disasters, acts of God, civil unrest, strikes; the Promoter may in its absolute discretion cancel the competition and recommence it from the start on the same conditions.
